## Help Families Get Connected

Digital technology affords people an assortment of avenues to connect with one another and the world around us, creating pathways to the resources and relationships we depend on to maintain our well-being. However, those without access to digital connections or devices fall behind in connecting with vital services and participating in modern society. A promising opportunity to strengthen digital access is through the [Affordable Connectivity Program](#) (ACP), which helps ensure households can afford the broadband they need for work, school, healthcare, and more. ACP is a benefit that provides a discount of up to \$30 per month toward internet service for eligible households and up to \$75 per month for households on qualifying Tribal lands. Eligible households can also receive a one-time discount of up to \$100 to purchase a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet from participating providers if they contribute more than \$10 and less than \$50 toward the purchase price.

Through The Patterson Foundation's trained [Digital Navigator Program](#), Digital Navigators are ready and willing to help eligible individuals enroll in the ACP and connect interested community members to low-cost home internet service, an affordable computing device, and foundational digital literacy training based on their specific needs.
